#### NATIONAL PRESIDENT

It is with great delight that I have to inform all our Branch Members that on Saturday  $9^{th}$  September 2017 our Branch Chairman Brian Burdus was elected as the National President of NARPO.

Brian was appointed to the Nottingham City Police in 1966 having previously served as a Cadet; he retired in 2005 having served 39 years.

During his career he was stationed at Central, Hucknall and Radford Road, he married Una and they had two children Andrew and Karen and 5 grandchildren, he was promoted to Sergeant and whilst in this rank he was elected as a Sergeants Representative

on the Sergeants Branch Board of the Nottinghamshire Police Federation. On his promotion to Inspector he retained his position on the Inspectors Branch Board and he went on to become the Chairman of Nottinghamshire Police Federation, he became the Regional Representative on the Inspectors Central Committee, Chairman of the Inspectors Central Committee, and Vice Chairman of the Joint Central Committee,

Brian has worked tirelessly on your behalf since his retirement in 2005, when he immediately joined Notts Branch of NARPO, he remained a Trustee to the Force Benevolent Funds, a position he had held whilst a serving officer and into retirement. He became our Branch Chairman in 2006 and our Regional Member of the National Executive Committee in 2010. He was elected as Vice President of NARPO in 2013, and continued to work as a Director for Age UK Nottingham and Nottinghamshire and also a Director of Age Concern Nottingham and Nottinghamshire.

The welfare of members had been important to Brian whilst serving and into retirement and he will continue in his roles within the Force together with his now National Commitments.

Brian has always been available for direction and advice, not only to the Branch Secretary but also the members and has supported a number of members especially during the recent Injury on Duty Reviews

#### CONFERENCE MATTERS

National Conference has now taken place at Scarborough, the main topic were the updated National Rules. During the debate on behalf of Nottinghamshire Branch Bruce Cameron proposed an amendment and John Kennedy seconded the proposal for inclusion of the definition of a Police Pension and entitlement to it as it affects Full members and also clarification on the exclusion of Full membership for someone who has been dismissed from the Police.

Although the proposals were opposed by the National Committee, Conference passed the amendments by a ratio of 3 to 1.

The New Rules will be circulated in due course to all members either by email, website or letter.

Membership will now be split into two categories

- 1. Full Members, this category will only be available to Retired Police Officers who are in receipt of a Police Pension or entitlement to a Police Pension had they not opted out of the scheme
- 2. Members, this category will be available to anyone who is not a Retired Officer and who wishes to join the Association as an Associate Member, this could include Serving Police Officers, Special Constabulary and Police Staff

Officers of the Branch and Conference Delegates will only be open to Full Members, although Members will be eligible to serve on the Branch Committee, provided they do not outnumber the Full Members on the Committee.

The Branch Committee will decide on membership, in the first instance this will be the Branch Secretary, in the case of any dispute or appeal it will be taken to the full Committee, their decision will be binding.

As a result of these changes it will be necessary to change our own Branch Rules but until this can be done we will operate under that National Rules
